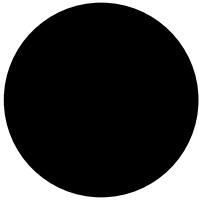

Suggestions for a way to not get stuck in problems

Building a base for resilience and making it a global community. (Arguments for strengthening, combining and empowering help structures)

The ultimate base would be to connect all the organizations and strategies and people that try to provide help structures to the people of the world that are suffering.

Every human being should be able to quickly find the help networks that are locally available and also be more aware of the global effort that is made every day to provide help and empower people. Many organization or some local support systems are just not very well known and that should be changed. (the organisations could be shown through visual maps and graphics, that analyze different aspects, organize them into different categories, interactive features, social events to get to know the organization, charity events, school workshops)

This platform would also try to make a statement in clearly showing that money is not the only way of support that individuals can show. (so it would describe who could contribute how, like for a graphic designer to provide free material for publicity or for a citizen to do volunteer work within the organization, or to organize events or to donate flowers for an event, journalists to provide news and updates, experts to answer questions,....whatever is needed)

This could start with defining one digital place like a website that combines all of these global help structures and organizes them.

The goal is to set up an online and also offline environment where the safety nets of the world are strengthened and easily available and seen by the public. (I think a main goal should be to reduce the suffrage in regard to the basic needs and wellness of human beings. Healthy human beings make better and more responsible decisions and healthy human beings can think critically or engage with global problems. **ONLY THE PRIVILEGED WILL BE PART OF THE DEBATE BECAUSE PERSONAL PROBLEMS OF SURVIVAL WILL ALWAYS COME FIRST.** And with a pandemic infrastructure of consistent fear of something, illness and loss a majority of people in the world have no resources to engage in the necessary change of fighting the rising climate crisis and all the huge catastrophes that follow naturally.)

The positive effect might be that we are focusing on giving people the freedom to fight for a better world instead of fighting against their daily suffrage. Every mind that is cared for might also have more caring ideas for others. This should also strengthen the focus on the good and the importance of care as well as the feeling of acceptance, love and care from others.

On the other hand, just pushing the world forward before getting everyone on board first might ruin the mission before it even began.

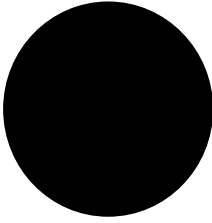
In times of crisis many do not have anything to rely on or trust in. So this will not lead to a natural openness to more change and uncertainty. To invest in strong and truthful social structures might be a way to give people a certainty and security that cannot be destroyed or changed that easily and helps to accept and deal with further uncertainty of new changes.

Therefore, investing in building that base of taking the time and complication of ALWAYS thinking about the safety options and nets for the people involved first might open up freedom for creative and caring thoughts.

Then the project can show resistance in troubling times because everyone was prepared. And in times of crisis most of us are already starting from a very vulnerable place adding that the risk of new problems arising is also very probable. To make sure that things won't get worse with the next hit of the crisis we need to know and be able to rely on our base structures well and efficiently.

We have growing social media places where people invest so many hours, energy and ideas. This should be channeled in a structure of the institutions and organizations that are providing help and safety. This should become a social media place that is not driven by data exploitation, but by the same engagement and interaction opportunities as social media platforms provide it. (only smarter, more responsible and less messy)

Reflecting on how we deal with information Data usage-Social media

Focusing on more diverse ways to search the internet and cluster information. Search engines don't do a great job in actually making the knowledge of the internet accessible or transparent.

We know that libraries always have a catalogue system of their collection and can provide knowledge of where exactly every part of knowledge is placed. This is very much needed for the internet.

And it is very questionable how we are forced to join social media platforms nowadays to access essential information or to adapt to PR strategies while our personal data is stored and analyzed.

Social media should always show the source of the bit of information and in times of AI it should give you the option to have an overview of where to place a statement within a broader subject or debate. Like giving you a visual chart of Pro and Con statement, mitigators or reevaluating the problem articles, where information is clustered.

Every social media user could be a more efficient information user by helping to organize the bits of information by having the option of visually questioning the source or clustering the information, connecting the information or creating their own or changing the algorithms that decide what one sees.

Another point may be to change the power structures of PR through social media by inventing more personal, fun and also effective ways to reach out a lot of people offline.

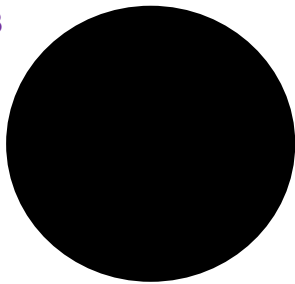
(Like analogue travel ideas. Like a piece of paper that is given to a friend or stranger that looks at it and then gives it to another person and so on.)

What would also help is to invent specific structures of how to deal and act on new information. (Government, hospitals, journalism, education system,...)

So that means to have protocols on how new information might be immediately brought into an idea space, then development space, action space and then evaluated for implementation for example. A huge problem seems to be that many institutions not have enough time or space to make use of new information within already well established structured because they are already fully occupied.

It does not matter how great the idea, or the bit of information is, if there is no room or space to use it, experiment with it and eventually implement change.

**Removing the obstacles first
-being aware of hidden values**

A very short but seemingly significant point for radical change is to realize what is preventing change.

As long as the publicity tells us that consumerism is the way what makes us happy or at least the best coping strategy and businesses depend on making more profit every year we might have a hard time changing radically.

Finding option to create another environment of this subtle advertising, which impact is crazily supported by social media, so that people might have less inner conflicts to listen to their own values instead of the inner kid that is steadily enforced by the power of a consumeristic society.

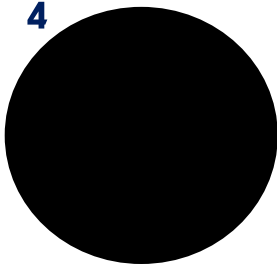
Advertising would need to change radically. In a way that emphasizes responsible behavior showing how we can work together with nature and animals around us instead of destroying and devaluing them. Or how time well spent,

and wellness is more important than any particular product.

It would be also helpful to turn more attention to the material of the product itself and its packaging. Supermarkets could for example provide the knowledge of what materials are used, where they come from, where they go, Pros and Cons and how sustainable they are. (this could be simplified by a pictogrammatic international language)

To create a better public sensibility to the daily use of materials there needs to be more public education and understanding of these materials and a stronger revolt for more responsible production and packaging might follow naturally.

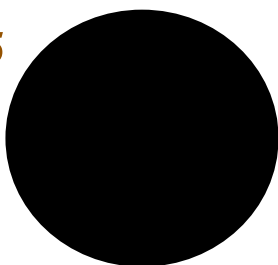

Providing an environment for recycling**

Creating a platform that makes waste accessible. A platform where big companies, institutions and individuals can upload their "waste" for others to reuse it. It consists of the input (people that have too much of something), the output (others who need, want this) and mitigation options (options for transport, long term contracts, options for places and tools to recycle, people with know-how, bureaucracy stuff, ...)

Roles-and open working environments

As working environments are getting more and more complex it might help to integrate new clear roles to simplify actions and secure that they do not fall under the table.

So to have for example the role of a collaborator like an artist's agent that works out new opportunities of collaboration. This could be a permanent role or one that is just fixed to a specific time or place.

If jobs seem to demand a variety of activities it might be very helpful to split them up into roles, which might provide a more helpful structure and secure that the important roles are not overseen.

Often times projects or working environments fail because the role of a critic, or the role of a conflict solver, or the role of _____ was very essential, but not fulfilled. If roles are transparently defined actions can follow with less stress, more respect, more structure and less conflict.

It also might be helpful to open up working environments to short time paid contributors. That means having at least one fixed open spot for changing short time contributors.

Because many education systems are not fit enough for the exploration of ones wishes or talents it might help a lot of people if more working environments would have a prepared structure, where new people could contribute and learn. This means thinking about ways to include new people with different backgrounds that are helpful for the company and for the individual as well. (Like making use of a new perspective and asking their opinions or about their insight if they have a special education in one field etc.)

This might help to foster exchange and give more individuals an opportunity to explore their strengths and develop different skills and engage in different working environments easily.

(This would also create an environment that is more open for project-based working.)
